1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Elliott 5.9 Class Association Rules and Safety Requirements shall apply
- 1.4 For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Elliott 5.9 class that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of the Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the contest entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Elliott 5.9 Nationals, Napier Sailing Club, P.O.Box, 12048, Napier or by

Emailing the contest entry form to manager@napiersailingclub.org.nz and depositing the required entry fee into the following bank account 03 0698 0040708 00 and providing the following details Particulars – Boat Name; Code – Sail Number; and Reference – Helmsperson Surname

Completed entries and fully paid entry fees must be received by Friday 21st November 2014.

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 1700 hours Wednesday 26 November 2014.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority.

4 FEES

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

Wednesday 26th November 2014
From 1500 to 18.00 hours

5.2 Measurement and inspection:

Wednesday 26th November 2014
From 1500 to 1800 hours

5.3 Briefing and welcome:

Thursday 27th November 2014 0900 hours

5.4 Racing schedule:

Thursday 27 th November 2014	4 races back to back.
Friday 28 th November 2014	4 races back to back.
Saturday 29 th November 2014	4 races back to back.

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the contest each day is 10.25 hours.

5.6 On Saturday 29th November no warning signal will be made after 16.30 hours.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 All boats must be in measured condition and carry correctors where applicable. Measurements will be taken to ensure boats meet class rules and safety regulations. Any sails not previously signed will also be measured.

6.3 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. NB a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after registration on Wednesday 27th November 2014 at the Napier Sailing Club.

8 VENUE & RACING AREA

The venue is the Napier Sailing Club, West Quay, Ahuriri, Napier. The sailing area is on the waters of Hawke Bay.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

11 SCORING

Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 6 to 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Napier Sailing Club ramps.



13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

14 PRIZEGIVING AND PRIZES

A prizegiving will follow the conclusion of the racing on Saturday 29th November – at the Napier Sailing Club. Prizes will be given as follows:

Elliott 5.9 Association National Trophies will be awarded including

- National Championship Trophy
- Owners Trophy
- One Ton Cup
- 40 Stones Trophy.
